



A new school for Brussels!

On 1 September 2018, the Tiener-school Anderlecht will open its doors.

The Tienerschool is a new school, tailored to Brussels teenagers. It will cater for pupils in the third stage of primary education and the first stage of secondary education, a unique concept!

Pupils between the ages of 10 and 14 go through many changes. During the early teens, they need the right support to gradually develop their own independence. Thanks to the intensive support of a team of enthusiastic expert teachers, who provide them with the personal follow-up they need during these 4 grades, the Tiener-school offers them the opportunity to do just that.

6 sound reasons to opt for the Tienerschool

1. The Tienerschool ensures a smooth transition between primary and secondary education. Primary and secondary-education curricula are seamlessly integrated. We avoid sudden change and an early choice of study. All pupils have an opportunity to acquaint themselves with the various areas of learning so that they get to discover their own passions, talents and interests which, in turn, will allow them to make a considered decision as to the course they would like to pursue.
2. Every pupil forms part of a core group. The core groups are guided by a mentor who regularly has a feedback chat with each pupil. During these meetings, the learning process and the pupil's personal well-being are focus of attention. Personal follow-up takes centre stage.
3. The Tienerschool is a community and inclusive school. It is the gateway to the world. We experiment together and regularly go into the city to explore it together. To facilitate that, we work with quite a number of organisations and partners. Even after school hours, the Tienerschool is buzzing with energy: pupils can avail of extra support or take part in a variety of activities.
4. At the Tienerschool, pupils learn by doing. We work interactively and encourage pupils to work together, with pupils from other core groups and grades included. This not only enhances their linguistic skills but also teaches them to work together in a respectful manner.
5. Step by step, we teach pupils to work independently. Through research, experiments, debating, projects, group and individual assignments, pupils learn to find answers to important issues themselves. Where possible, pupils are given certain school-related responsibilities.
6. Parents are important partners. From day 1, we want to involve them in their child's learning process and the school activities inasmuch as possible. Choosing for the Tienerschool is choosing for a caring community that has the interests of today's teenagers at heart.

Who can attend the Tiener-school?

The Tienerschool caters for youngsters between the ages of 10 and 14 years. Anyone born in 2007, 2008 and 2009 can register for the 2018-2019 school year.

On 1 September 2018, we start off with the first, second and third Tienerschool grades.
